## Messy Family Fun

The Messy Family Fun Holiday is a place for families to come together and enjoy a break based on creativity, hospitality and celebration. If you are involved in a Messy Church then this is a chance to experience the Messy Church atmosphere over the course of a holiday. If you haven't experienced Messy Church, why not come along and see what all the fuss is about?

#### What is Messy Church?

Messy Church is a way of being church for families involving lots of fun! It's a church - not a craft club - that allows families to encounter Jesus. Messy Church is for adults and children to enjoy together and it uses handson activities to explore Bible stories, to reflect on a God of creativity and to give families a chance to play together. Messy Church is about hospitality, expressed through eating together!



Messy Family Fun Holidays takes place at Lendrick Muir, an SU Scotland centre near Kinross. Accommodation is in comfortable dorms, one per family, and there is plenty of space for indoor activities as well as space to relax. Set in 120 acres of glorious grounds, there is a lot to explore outside as well.



Messy Family Fun Holiday is led by Jen Robertson (SU Scotland Regional Worker for Lanarkshire & Hamilton Presbytery) with help from a team of fully accredited SU Scotland volunteers and staff.



The cost for Messy Family Fun is **£90** per adult and **£50** per child (under 16), there is no cost for children 2 and under. [Age at time of the holiday]

A deposit of £20 per person (age 3 plus) is due at time of booking.

Included in the cost:

- Accommodation
- Food
- All Messy Family Fun Activities (incl. some site activities provided by Lendrick Muir)









#### Atypical day at Messy Family Fun

The day starts with breakfast together with other Messy families in our dining rooms with food for all ages. During the day there'll be opportunities to play outside together, exploring the beautiful grounds of Lendrick Muir: toddling around wide grassy areas, early climbing experiences in our toddlers play area, swinging on the swings in the adventure playground or leaping on the low ropes course for the more advanced!

We have loads of activities to explore different parts of the Bible – it will be Messy and fun and each day we will celebrate together with stories, songs and prayer.

Lunch and dinner will be served back in our dining rooms, and we round off the day maybe with a bonfire or a film. To give adults a chance to relax in the evening, once smaller people have gone to bed, there'll be a free babysitting service which you can use, ensuring the children are safe in their rooms while you relax in the comfortable lounges.
