You Belong Here: Discover God (and SU Holidays!)



- Invite pupils to discover the message that they belong here with God, at SU Group, at SU Holidays
- Introduce and invite pupils to SU Holidays especially those who've never been before



1. WELCOME AND GAME (5-10 minutes)

What Kind of Camper Are You?

How it works:

- Mark the 4 corners of the room with A, B, C, D signs
- Call out a scenario and assign a new label to each corner based on potential responses
- Pupils run to the corner that fits them best.
- Optional: If you have more time, ask 1-2 volunteers to share why they made their choice.

Round 1: Free Time Fun

Question: You've got a free hour at camp — where are you headed?

- A: Sports field
- B: Down to the loch/lake
- C: Chill and snack zone
- D: Craft space

Round 2: Talent Show Time

Question: What is your role in the talent show?

- A: Performing on stage
- B: Backstage or tech
- C: Hyping the crowd
- D: Cheering from the audience

Round 3: Faith Moment

Question: What would you look forward to most at Bible times?

- A: Worship music
- B: Quietly exploring the Bible
- C: Group chats or Q&As
- D: Experiencing God in nature

Round 4: Team Challenge

Question: Your team is doing a wacky challenge. What is your role?

- A: Thinking up the strategy
- B: Taking the big risks
- C: Making everyone laugh
- D: Helping others feel included

"Look how different everyone is — and there's a spot for all of us. That's the best part about camp ... you belong here."



2. VIDEO - INTRODUCING SU HOLIDAYS (4-8 minutes)

- Show the SU Holidays video
- If you have time, invite pupils to share what parts they would like to try themselves.



3. BIBLE MESSAGE - "COME AND SEE" JOHN 1:35-46 (4-8 minutes)

Read the passage or invite a pupil to do so.

Provide Bibles or print outs of the passage for others to follow along.

In this passage we see people meeting, or hearing about, Jesus for the first time. They understandably have questions!

- What is one question you have about Jesus?
- What response do Jesus and Philip give to the questions, and is that how you would expect to have your questions answered? (v39 and v46)
- Why do you think Jesus (and then later Philip) invite people to 'come and see' rather than just telling them the answer to their question?
- What do you find exciting about being invited to 'come and see' who Jesus is? What do you find frustrating?



4. REFLECTION (3-5 minutes)

Invite the young people to reflect (and pray if they wish) quietly or in small groups

- Do I want to come and see more of who Jesus is?
- Do I believe that I belong with Jesus and will be welcomed by him? If not, could I ask him to break down any barriers that are stopping me believing I belong with him?



5. TESTIMONY "WHY I BELONG AT CAMP" (3-5 minutes)

If you have time, you might want to play the testimony video or invite someone who has experienced an SU Holiday as a child share some of their story. It might be helpful to include:

- What they were nervous about
- How they found their place
- A faith highlight
- · What made them feel they belonged



6. NEXT STEPS (2-5 minutes)

Share:

• The SU Holidays website with dates and camps available (Highlight any holidays where someone local is on team)

- That help with costs is available
- The SU Holidays brochures with camp details written in by you, the group leader what events could you recommend?
- Time for questions
